
ANNE BOLEYN'S HAPPY GRAPH

Between 1505, when Anne Boleyn's family inherited Hever Castle, and 1536 Anne had times when she was very happy, and times when she was very sad. Using the timeline, plot Anne's happiness on the graph below.



TIMELINE

- 1505 Anne Boleyn's father, Thomas, inherits Hever Castle and the family move from Blickling Hall in Norfolk.
- 1513 At around the age of 12, Anne Boleyn is sent to Brabant in the Low Countries to become one of Archduchess Margaret of Austria's maids of honour.
- 1515 Anne goes to France to join the household of Queen Claude, wife of King Francis I. Anne remains with Claude for seven years.
- 1522 Anne returns home to England and joins the household of Catherine of Aragon, Henry VIII's first wife.
- 1523 Anne is told that she cannot marry Henry Percy. Percy was sent to London by his father. Thomas Boleyn banishes Anne to Hever.
- 1527 Anne receives the first of 17 love letters from Henry VIII.
- 1528 Anne became seriously ill with the sweating sickness and returned to Hever to get well.
- 1532 Anne is given the title of Marquess of Pembroke and goes to France with Henry VIII to meet King Francis I.
- 1533 Anne secretly marries Henry VIII and is crowned Queen. She also gives birth to Elizabeth I.
- 1536 Anne is beheaded by a French swordsman and Henry VIII marries Jane Seymour 11 days later.
