13th Greenside development Completion August 2022

- Dual sided gabions to river bank stopping erosion.
- Relocation of the bridge to take wear away from close to the green.
- Re-landscaping areas and improving ecology.

This project follows the success of the Gabion support work carried out on the 12th and 6th holes.

Future developement:

A future target maybe be the 5th hole to prevent river bank erosion.



Bunker Developement 1st Hole Championship Course

- This year we will be reshaping the large greenside bunker on the 1st hole.
- We have designed 2 smaller bunkers to replace the very large bunker.
- Enhancing the bunker to play from and being able to maintain the standard is our aim.
- We will be trialing new sand in these bunkers with the objective of improved playabilty.

Future aspirations for bunker developement:

- 3rd 14th
- 8th 18th







Tee Developement Infrastructure

- Our 30 year old irrigation system must be upgraded first. If it didn't we would be re-leveling tees this year.
- In 2022 we are investing in some of the most significant and costly parts of this system, with new pumps and central control systems installed.
- This new irrigation structure also helps us with efficient use of water, vital to all our Greens, Approaches and Tees.



Our Overall Tee Development Plan:

- Create wider spaces for some of our tees to help prevent wear and give more options for tee positions.
- Have path positions to restrict wear and tear around our tees .
- To include winter tee positions purpose built into the landscaping scheme.

Future Aspirations for Tee Development:

The 6th tee is a high profile feature project to give a wide range of teeing positions on our front 9 character par 3.





Planned Pathway Developement:

Improvements to the existing pathways that run thoughout the course for easier access and improved mobility.





Members Access Prioritised:

Weekend Golf Days will no longer be accepted to provide more access for members and their guests.







Fairway Investments Sustained

- We have increased our annual budgets to include the reseeding of fairways and hope to preserve this as long as it is helpful.
- Fertilisers and seed are applied for best effect when the temperatures are right.
- The actions increases the grass growth significantly for a period.
- Cutting routines have to be modified to and will be more labour intensive to keep grass growth under control.

The results we have seen last year, we believe are worth the extra expense and pressure on our labour. We aim to give you the best fairways for as long as possible throughout the season.

2022 Waterside Hospitality Developments


- -The team's focus is aimed at maintaining a friendly welcoming atmosphere, while providing a variety of catering options to satisfy a range of customer requirements.
- -A Grab & Go menu is being offered from the Spike Bar, which will offer golfers smaller snacks and take out options, ideal if you don't have the time to stay and eat from the main bar menu.
- -Significant Kitchen upgrades allow our chef's to deliver some favourites for the first time. This summer you will be offered options from our Chargrill, including steaks and burgers, plus we will offer a traditional fish and chips.

Kitchen Developement 2022






Parking Facility Development
