Ruggeri Argeo, Prosecco Brut, Veneto, Italy, NV *	£44.00
Delicate, zesty Prosecco, exuding green apples and citrus	
Abel Lepitre, Idèale Cuvée, Brut Champagne, France *	£52.50
A result of the blend of three great varieties of grapes: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. Delicate and light, always loyal to its style, pleasantly fruity, ideal for either an aperitif or a celebration.	
Squerryes, Vintage Brut, Kent, 2014 *	£56.00
On the palate, there is a real intensity of fruit with crisp orchard apples and pears, complemented by some light brioche notes and the characteristic long Squerryes finish.	
The Bolney Estate, Classic Cuvee, Sussex, NV	£70.00
Delightful hedgerow fruits and brioche notes combine with sweet apple and stone fruits. Fresh and elegant with a good body and persistent mousse.

Benchmark sparkling English wine with delicate fruit aromas and rich toastiness on the finish

A very fruity wine with great balance - intense, crisp and refreshing	
Sauvignon Blanc, Lanya, Chile, 2021 *	£28.00
Pale lemon with green tints - the nose is fresh and lemony with herbaceous notes. Elegant and well balanced with tropical notes and grapefruit on the palate.	
Ken Forrester, Petit Chenin, Western Cape, South Africa, 2022 *	£38.00
Real freshness on the palate with crunchy green apple and grapefruit flavours	
Albariño Martín Códax, 2020 *	£45.50
Vivid straw-yellow green colour with a touch of ripe lemon. The nose is intense and elegant with hints of fresh herbs, green apples, citric fruits and grapefruit.	
Francesco Cirelli, Pecorino IGT Colline Pescaresi Organic, Abruzzo, Italy, 2021 *	£49.00
Crisp and refreshing, floral and zippy with lemon, the mouth a bowlful of mango and papaya.	
Sauvignon Blanc, Yealands Estate, 2021 *	£44.50
The nose is intense and elegant with hints of fresh herbs, green apples, citric fruits and grapefruit.	
Alain Chavy, Bourgogne Chardonnay, Burgundy, France, 2020	£57.50
Tantalising aromas of buttered toast and Champagne lead into a beautifully balanced, creamy palate of poached pears offset by fine, lean acidity.	
Hattingley Valley, Still Chardonnay, Hampshire, England, 2020	£61.00
The palate is clean and fresh, with a mouthful of green apple flavours, and a creamy texture that is nicely balanced with its natural vibrant bright acidity.

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ROSE

Il Sospiro Pinot Grigio Blush, Italy, 2021 * **£28.00**
 The definition of easy-drinking, this Sicilian Pinot Grigio blush exhales cranberry, citrus and red berries

Vidaubanaise, Provence Rosé, Provence, France, 2021 * **£45.50**
 Notes of rose petals, pomegranate and strawberries -silky smooth and light

RED

Care, Tinto Sobre Lias, Cariñena, Spain, 2021 * **£28.50**
 Fragrant and ripe red and black fruit with great balance

Chilean Merlot, Los Tortolitos, Chile, 2021 * **£28.00**
 Fresh, raspberry and strawberry nose, with a light and juicy palate bursting with forest fruit.

El Esteco, Don David Malbec, Salta, Argentina, 2021 * **£41.00**
 Ripe, lush cherries with plum jam, tobacco, dark chocolate and vanilla

Valpolicella Ripasso DOC, Bertani, 2021 * **£61.00**
 Violet red colour. Intense notes of black currant red plums, raspberry, black cherry and spice. Good fresh attack on the palate followed by good balance between acidity, sweetness and body.

Château Sainte Marie Red Supérieur, 2019 **£47.50**
 Beautifully concentrated blackcurrant, dark fruit and plum fill the nostrils and then cleanse the palate.

Seresin Estate, Leah Pinot Noir Organic, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2018 **£57.50**
 Bright, fragrant, berry-fruit aromas, interlaced with spice and herbal notes.

Louis Martini, Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma, USA, 2018 **£61.00**
 The wine offers ripe flavours of blackcurrant and jammy black plum accented by notes of caramelised oak and sweet spice.

Ramón Bilbao, Rioja Gran Reserva, Rioja, Spain, 2018 **£63.00**
 Deep ruby in colour with an expressive nose of black fruits with toasted aromas. Perfect balance on the palate with silky tannins, fresh acidity and superb concentration of flavours.

DESSERT WINE AND PORT

Lucien Lurton Garonelles Sauternes, 2015 **£44.00**
 Elegant Sauternes, heady with pineapple and mango, the tropicality finely balanced with citrus.

Quinta do Crasto unfiltered LBV Port, 2015 * **£52.50**
 Fine tannins form a trellis supporting wild blackberries and other wild fruit, while a waft of cacao supplies welcome savouriness and balance.

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
