Drainage

Following the successful fairway drainage over the front 9 of the Championship Course, we are pleased to confirm that we are now rolling this out onto the back 9 with plans to tackle 2 of the wetter holes.

We will start with the 11th and 15th holes as we work to our objective of offering a robust 18 holes, playable in the worst of winters.

17th Hole Redesign and New Tee Build

Whilst novel due to its extreme length, the 17th hole was often quoted as the weakest hole on the course by members and visitors alike, perhaps a bit much in midst of an already difficult series of holes.

Set back in the trees, the new tee offers views over the front 9 and the Hever Lake, leading to a gentle dogleg right, with the green and pin visible from the tee around 540 yards away.





Halfway Hut

Our new halfway hut is now open with a nice seating area offering views across the course.

We look forward to the new food offerings this will support as we move into the main season.

Expanded Green Complexes

Last year we expanded the fine turf areas around some of the greens, increasing playability and allowing a wide range of shot types giving you the best chance of getting up and down!

We are expanding this to other greens across the course.





New Ball Machine

We are installing an upgraded ball machine and user interface to improve reliability and functionality, helping us maintain competitive member rates and support future range upgrades.

Annual Maintenance Week

Having done a lot of work to the greens over the years, we are now in a position to limit the disruption during annual maintenance week by alternating greens work between the 9's each year.

This means we will now be able to offer 18 holes of golf during annual maintenance week with either the Boleyn Course, Princes > Kings or the new Cleves Course, Princes > Queens.

This year will see the Cleves Course in operation for the first time. We look forward to running a members' competition over the course this year, establishing the course record.
